



## Bridgemont Accepts Development Newsmaker of the Year Award

### **Golf Inc. Magazine Recognizes Bridgemont and Sevierville**

**Austin, TX April 3, 2007.** Golf Inc. magazine has recognized Sevierville, Tennessee's Bridgemont Resort development and the City of Sevierville's Eagle's Landing golf courses as one of the nation's top ten golf development projects underway. Both courses are expected to be completed and ready for play in the spring of 2009. Construction will be managed so that 18 holes of golf will always be open and playable.
